Digital Image Sizes

Images must be in JPEG and not more than 1600 pixels wide by 1200 pixels high

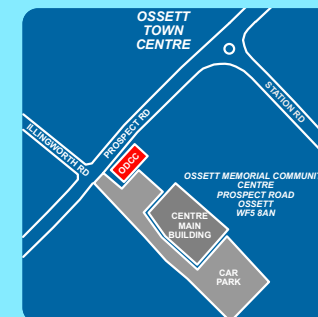
